**AMY LIN “*SILENCE*’ OPENING AT
HEINEMAN MYERS CONTEMPORARY ART**

Opening reception November 14th, 6-9pm

Artist talk at 7pm

Bethesda, Maryland: Heineman Myers contemporary art proudly presents the recent drawings of Amy Lin at a reception for the artist on Wednesday, November 14th from 6 to 9pm at 4728 Hampden Lane in Bethesda. Amy Lin will speak about her work at 7pm.

In this body of work, Amy Lin continues to explore the use of colored pencil-drawn dot, using Prisma color wax-based pencils, on a larger scale than ever before. A preview of the work in this exhibit may be viewed at www.amylinart.com.

Lin’s work was selected for the 2006 edition of “New American Paintings” where curator Stephen Bennett Phillips described her work as “a string of dots, each of which is energized by an interior dot, producing a web of rhythmic lines in her lyrical work.”

Anne Collins Goodyear, Assistant Curator of Prints and Drawings at the National Portrait Gallery, suggests that “a careful examination of these lively surfaces reveals fascinating intersections between the minute units themselves – microbes of a sort – some of which seem to cohere with a magnetic pull and while others seem to resist one another.”

Amy Lin’s work was just recently selected by Apple, the computer manufacturer, for use in an international marketing campaign aimed at college students.

In May, 2007, “Washingtonian” magazine selected Amy Lin as one of the city’s “40 under 40” people to watch.
